

AP Test Information for Spring, 2015

The spring, 2015 **Advanced Placement Exams** are scheduled to be taken nation-wide on May 4-15. AP exams can be taken at Mount Vernon High School. The exams cover many different content areas: Language Arts, Science, Math, Music, Art, Social Studies, World Languages and others. In the past, MVHS students have taken English Language, English Literature, US Government, Calculus, Physics, German, Spanish, Chemistry, Psychology, Macro and Microeconomics Exams. Schedules for the exams may be found at the College Board website listed above.

Students may prepare for the exams in many different ways. Those who have taken AP Courses online this year will automatically take the exams, but students who have taken honors or higher level courses at Mount Vernon are also eligible to take the AP exams. Additional preparation is available via online study guides that can help students review.

Teachers will inform students about AP Exams during their honors classes. Students are encouraged to register by Friday, February 27. Students may register in the high school counselor's office. Registration must include a list of exams that are to be taken and \$50 fee **for each exam**. (The actual exam fee is \$89/exam. The school district will pay the difference). Checks may be made payable to **Mount Vernon High School** and turned in to Ms. Baron in the counseling office. AP Exam results are received in July with a score ranging from 1 to 5. A score of 5 is the highest score. A score of 3 or higher is usually recognized by most colleges as an acceptable level to receive college credit. *The awarding of college credit is specific to each college*, thus parents and students should always check, in advance of testing, with each institution regarding the details for receiving AP credit.

No late testing will be scheduled.
